## TECH SESSION: update Ken Willard's 64 Spider

Dave Ellis, Steve Dietrick and Jim Cleveland attended the Tech Session at Ken Willards home on Sept. 7, to have a look at getting Ken's Corvair spider to stay running. We set the points, got the car running though not very well. It was determined that perhaps the Turbo should be rebuilt. After all the car has been sitting for a long period of time.

Well a day or so passed and Ken had a light bulb go on in his head.......Stuck Valves, he has run the car so little in past year that at least one intake valve was hung up in its guide. So he doctored the oil with a heavy dose of 'top end additive' and within 15 minutes of struggling to idle, little by little the car started to run quite a bit better, now almost no coughing and spitting or backfiring. He is going to to start the car every couple of days and as it improves, run it a bit longer and at higher RPM's. It sounds Ken would like someone to give the car a run around the block, as he suspects the motor would really like to get some exercise befor the snow flies. Paul Abel has already volunteered.
