Introduction of the RPO 690 Turbocharged Corvair engine has made possible release of a new exhaust valve suitable for heavy duty usage. This valve consists of a heat resistant alloy head welded to a Silichrome "1" valve stem with built-in rotation features.

In the event of unsatisfactory exhaust valve life on 1960-62 Corvair standard or hi-performance (RPO 649) engines operating under sustained high-speed or heavy load conditions, the "Turbocharger" Exhaust Valve and Key Unit should be used for Service replacement.

This recommendation does not affect valve usage on Corvair "95" engines or normal replacement of valves on other Corvair engines.
