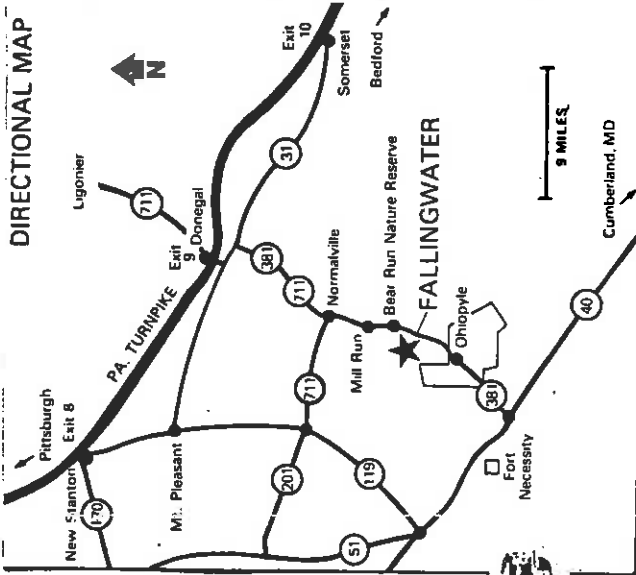


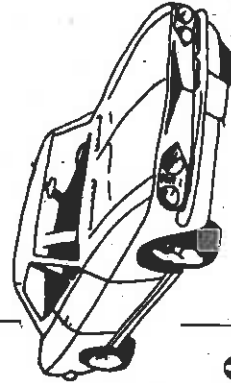

WITH A SLIDE PRESENTATION AFTER THE OCTOBER MEETING.

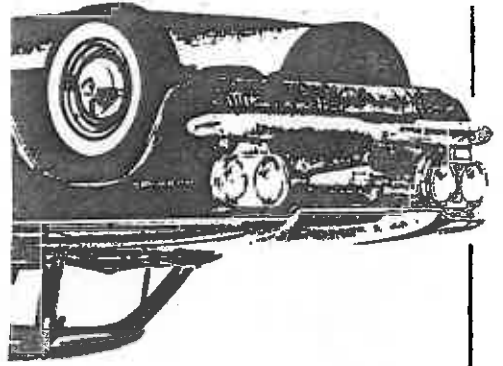
IN THIS ISSUE OF THE JOURNAL YOU WILL FIND

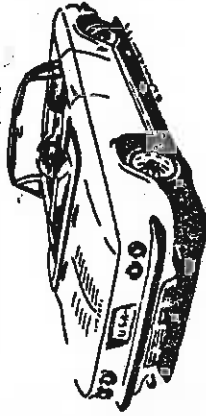

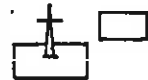
