

SATURDAY, AUGUST 20, 2005 10:00 AM DEPARTURE

- Packsaddle Covered Bridge
- Gravity Hill
- Glen Savage Ranch
- The Compass Inn Stagecoach Layover.

We will embark from the Latrobe McDonald's on Route 30, just East of the Route 981 intersection near the Arnold Palmer Airport.

Departure is at 10:00 AM sharp. PLEASE BE THERE EARLY TO GET YOUR BACK IN TIME FLIGHT PLAN AND PRE TAKEOFF BRIEFING.

Ralph & Joanna Shearer and Al & Carole Friend are teaming up to bring you a very interesting and beautiful tour through time and through parts of the Laurel Highlands that you didn't even know existed. This is a joint event with The Western Pa. Region of AACA, so expect to see a super line up of antique cars and trucks.

Our nostalgic adventure will begin with a familiar drive through the Chestnut Ridge via the Loyalhanna Gorge, up and over the Laurel Ridge, then gradually back to the early eighteen hundreds when the pace of life was slower. You will feel the tensions of modern day America melt away.

In your mind your antique car or truck will become a horse and buggy or a Model T Ford as you drive it through the vintage Packsaddle covered bridge, which was built in 1870 right over a waterfall on Brush Creek. It is a fire engine red example of multiple kingpost construction, AND IS A MUST SEE, you will never find it on your own! Bring your camera.

While working our way toward the bridge along narrow Glen Savage Road, you will be startled by the sudden sight of a huge statue of a Pennsylvania elk atop the entrance way to the Glen Savage Ranch and hunting lodge. Guess what folks, the ranch has a beautiful, rustic, barn

like buffet restaurant that will be open ONLY TO US. After our stay at Packsaddle Bridge we will have a wonderful and refreshing, all you can eat, rest stop at the ranch. The Shearers and Friends attest that it is a bargain at \$9.95 plus tax and your beverages. Take care of your own tab.

After this delightful pause that refreshes we will press on to Gravity Hill. No matter if it's your first visit or your tenth, you will giggle like a young school girl as Gravity Hill drives your senses senseless. After Joanna & Ralph's show & tell demonstrations, we will drive back in time to the late seventeen hundreds at the Compass Inn, situated at the base of Laurel Mountain, it served as a popular stagecoach stopover in the late 1700s and early 1800s. Costumed guides will teach you more than you can imagine about those, not so good, old days on the American frontier. If we have at least 20 stagecoach passengers we will get the group rate of \$5. The senior rate is also \$5.
