My '64 convertible was rescued in '69 just before it was to go off to the salvage yard. My husband, John, worked for an insurance company and the car was an unrecovered stolen car. After settling up with the insured, the car was recovered. Before sending it to the junk yard, the company decided to put it up for bids. John had been a mechanic in a previous job, working mostly on Corvairs, so he decided to turn in a bid. He got the car for \$60 or \$80, I'm not sure which. After some body work and paint, it was ready for the road.

I first saw the car in the summer of 1970. I had a two month old '70 Camaro and offered John an even swap. Not sure how serious I was but it didn't matter because the offer was not accepted. I had

owned a '64 convertible a few years before and really liked it.

After John and I started dating, I could always tell when he was bringing the Corvair. From a block away I could recognize the distinctive sound of the engine.

In the fall of '73 John found a note on the windshield about a recently formed club that met in a garage in Leechburg and he started attending. My first event was a picnic the following summer at the home of Ivan Clever, the founder of WPCC.
