

From the Editor...My Story, the Last

Y FIRST CORVAIR WAS A brand new 1962 red on red Monza Coupe. I loved that car, but sorry to say I traded it for another new car in 1968 (I won't mention the new car's brand name).

Skip ahead to 1980...A work associate and I often talked about cars when time allowed. When I first talked about my '62 Corvair, he mentioned the name, Wayne Jones, (who died a number of years ago) and referred to him as a "Corvair nut." After contacting and talking to Wayne, I began to have visions of Corvairs, dancing in my head.

After looking at number of possibilities, I found a maroon on black '64 convertible that was for sale. I had always dreamed of owning a rag top. So the paint wasn't the best but that could be changed to red, and so it was.

It was 1981; I joined WPCC when meetings were held every month at the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Monroeville. I still have the very first Vair Street Journal I received. it's postmarked, 21 NOV 1981. The type was generated on a typewriter. There was a special bonus page in that issue: a complete list of all the club members...96 of them.

I started doing the Journal in 1982. Al Friend and Wayne Jones probably talked me into it. At the time I was a graphic designer for an ad agency and when my typesetter learned that I was doing a newletter with a typewriter, she volunteered to set type for me. Good-bye good old Royal typewriter.

Wayne Jones, coordinated the printing of the Journals. He worked

as a salesman for Allegheny Bindery and had lots of contacts in the Pittsburgh area. He managed to have one of the in-house printers at Calgon print the Journal every month, at no charge of course. Yes, it was a monthly back then, just like the meetings

But there were three growing children at home who needed to be educated and I guess my responsibilities at work and those at home caused me to give up the Journal. Bates Murphy took it over just about the time I was loosing some of my interest in Corvairs. I dropped out of the Club as an active member for a few years.

In that interim WPCC had a female president one year. I met her at a drag race after I rejoined the club. She told me she was having her Corvair redone, but the car never resurfaced and she dropped out of the club somewhere along the way.

Sometime during the nineties the meetings and Journals became bimonthly. Vaun Hamlin was doing the Journals. A year or two or three passed; I'm not sure, but Vaun said he was moving out of state and asked if I would take over the Journal. It was 2001; I said "yes."

Wayne Rockhill, president of WPCC at the time, was in poor health after a number of years of good health that followed a heart and double lung transplant. I took over the Journal just before Wayne's death. My first issue, October/November 2001, had Wayne's picture and his obituary on the cover. Inside was a photo of

Darlene, we thank you for taking on the job of treasurer.


The After Christmas Christmas Party

Vaun & Charlotte Hamlin who were moving to Florida.

By 2001 I had my own Mac computer at home. I created the Journals and generated a copy on my ink jet printer. The next step was to take the printed copy to Kinko's where they copied and printed it. Then I folded, labeled and stamped the Journals and took them to the nearest mailbox or post office. In the end, the print quality of the Journal was fair at best.

Postage rates were climbing, so in 2007, we decided to put the Journal out in e-mail form. We reasoned that everyone owned a computer. I suppose we have a few folks who actually don't own a computer, or if they do, are unwilling to pass along their e-mail address. However, the majority of members did and began receiving their newsletter in full color via the Internet.

By the time the Journal was going out in e-mail form, I had a newer computer and was able to put the Journal's digital information into PDF form (portable document format), which allowed me to put it on a flash drive, take it to Office Depot and have high quality hard copies printed for the folks who receive the Journal via snailmail. It was a real step forward in print quality.

That's pretty much my story before the announcement at the Christmas Party that I would no longer be doing the newsletter. I have enjoyed creating Vair Street Journals over these many years, but I think it's time to let someone else take over. Joyce Bachman has graciously accepted the responsibility of keeping you informed about what's happened and what's about to happen with the Western Pennsylvania Corvair Club.
