

Unfortunately I cannot pass judgement on any of the four wine cellars that we visited. Sorry dear reader, I do not take alcohol. I was along for the ride and to learn something about wineries and to take some pictures.

Our next stop took us to the delightful Freeport Restaurant, located at the juncture of Routes 5 and 9, also in North East. I can vouch for the excellent food that is served there.

Indianhead Wine Cellars was next, followed by Quincy Cellars Winery, and finally Lakeview Wine Cellars.




