

#### Wine Tasting with Jim & Heidi Maddens

At about 9:30 a.m. on Saturday October 1, fourteen WPCC members, driving five Corvairs and one modern iron, left the Krispy Kreme in Cranberry and drove up Route 19 to Rachel's Roadhouse for a delicious lunch. The restaurant is located a few miles south of I-80 and for anyone traveling in that area, this is definitely a place to bookmark. Attending were our tour leaders, Jim & Heidi Madden, followed by Bill & Joan Artzberger, Don Baker, Don & Mary Ellen Cekus, Vince & Louise Duva, Pat Greenwald & her brother Richard Comer, Jim & Suzanne Heatherington and Les Walter.

Gary's presentation included the information that their business is a result of "a hobby that got out of control." Wilhelm wine is served at Isabela on Grandview, a very highend eatery up on Mt. Washington.

Then some of us visited other tourist-y shops in Volant, as it was pleasant to stroll around on a day that was refreshingly cool. After that, we all headed back down Route 19 to our various homes. 
