

September 23, 2014 Member Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by President Don Cekus.

The minutes of the May meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter.

The treasurer's report showed a balance of \$3,122.92 .There was income of \$12.00 in dues and a \$48.00 correction and expenses of \$15.07 for the newsletter.

Don reported on his trip to the CORSA Convention in Tacoma.

Discussion followed concerning the holiday party. Terry Washington reported the results of her researching a change of venue. The Marriott in Cranberry offered 3 choices:



Tech Tip...A Review of Fanbelt Basics

The fanbelt transmits drive torque so the engine can turn its various accessories. "V-belts" transmit torque by gripping the pulley grooves with their sides. If a belt is not tight, and slips, friction between the sides of the belt and the pulley generate heat and noise (belt squeal). This slippage can glaze the sides of the belt and make it slip all the more, accelerating wear and the aging process which will eventually cause belt failure.

Periodic belt inspection should be a vital part of your Corvair's maintenance routine. The illustrations shown here are belt defects that you should be looking for. When you see any of these signs, belt replacement is good insurance. Always replace the belt with one of the proper width, lengths and "v-angle".


Correct Corvair belts all have a "v-angle" of 38°, and a width of 3/8" (Diagram A), and are intended to ride low in the pulley groove as shown. A belt which is too wide or has the wrong angle (Diagram B), will ride too high in the pulley, prematurely wearing out, and possibly flipping off.



Belt Cover Slip




Underside Cracked

Rapid Sidewall Wear



Classic Inspection Stickers Add a Finishing Touch

hether you have invested \$1,000 or \$50,000 into a classic auto, here is one of the most striking things you can add as a finishing touch to your car for under \$25 – Bob Hoyt's classic inspection sticker to match the state and year of your car.

Now retired, a preacher by trade, Bob spent 15 years restoring his Studebader Champion. While looking for parts in a junkyard a few years ago, he noticed an ancient New Jersey inspection sticker. Taking a digital photo, he restored and reproduced the sticker on his computer and attached it to his Studebaker. It was an immediate hit at every car show Hoyt attended.

Fifteen years later, he has accumulated over 3,000 original inspection stickers from every state in the U.S., Canada and



several foreign countries. They are almost identical to the originals, and for prices as low as \$15 you can obtain one for your car to match the state, year and even include your license plate number to go on the inside of you windshield, exactly like the original did (except for Hawaii and some California stickers that went outside of the car).

Browse thru his web site and you can find everything from WW2 gas ration stickers to tax stamps to door oil change stickers.
